- Ethical sustainability includes the impact on people and animals as well as planet - exploitation for resources and labour, treatment, welfare. Fair pay and working conditions.
- Compassionate designer with a passion for improving the interior design industry and its impact - its use of animal products leather, skins & fur, wool & yarns, silk, down, feather, bone. Many of us avoid toiletries and cleaning products that are tested on animals - paints, adhesives coatings may also be animal tested. The first UK designer to be Vegan Design Certified
- **Circular economy designer** avoiding use virgin materials & fossil fuels, reuse and valuing waste as a resource, encouraging long lasting specifications, ease of repair rather than short-living trends
- **Regenerative designer** 'Living Future Accredited' completed study to support Living Building Challenge projects - energy use, CO2 use, waste reduction, water footprint, ecology, enhancing through projects and the communities they sit within
- Healthy materials advocate and follower of the human centric design movement studied Parson's Materials Lab Healthier Materials & Sustainable Building, WELL, Fitwel®. Measure and monitoring features of the built environment that impact human health and wellbeing including air quality, water, nourishment, light, fitness, comfort and mental health
